How to complete a location:

Consult the list of cities in the Global Alert Network map. A city will be marked Active once field intelligence on at least 1 post office has been submitted. The strength of our Global Alert Network system will increase the more information is gathered within a city. Multiple agents should submit field intelligence to ensure optimal surveillance strength.

Level 1: Isolated

- Intel gathered on 1 post office branch by one agent.

Level 2: Localized

- Intel gathered on 2 or more post office branches by one agent.

Level 3: District Wide

- Intel gathered on 4 or more post office branches by multiple agents.

Level 4: City Wide

- Intel gathered on 8 or more post office branches by multiple agents.

How to monitor a Post Office:

We require the following pieces of Field Intelligence to update the Global Alert Network - One photograph of the front of the post office branch and the 3 strongest wifi networks in the area.

Online mapping tools, such as Google Streetview, do not provide the most recent photos, thus all photos must be gathered by agents in the field.

To obtain the network details, use your mobile device to scan for the three strongest signals within the post office, or within a 50 foot radius. Take a screenshot of your device showing all available networks.

How to submit Field Intelligence:

Once you have gathered necessary Field Intelligence from a post office in your area of operations, upload it to our network using the Global Alert Network website's "Submit Photo Here" button (<http://intrusion.blackwatchmen.com>).

Best Field Practices:

Active Field Agents should act in a manner that does not bring unwanted attention to themselves or the Agency. The scope of the enemy's network is unknown at this time, thus all agents must not raise any suspicion. Be sure to obey all local laws, do not trespass and do not engage with potential threats in the field. OPSEC is a top priority.
